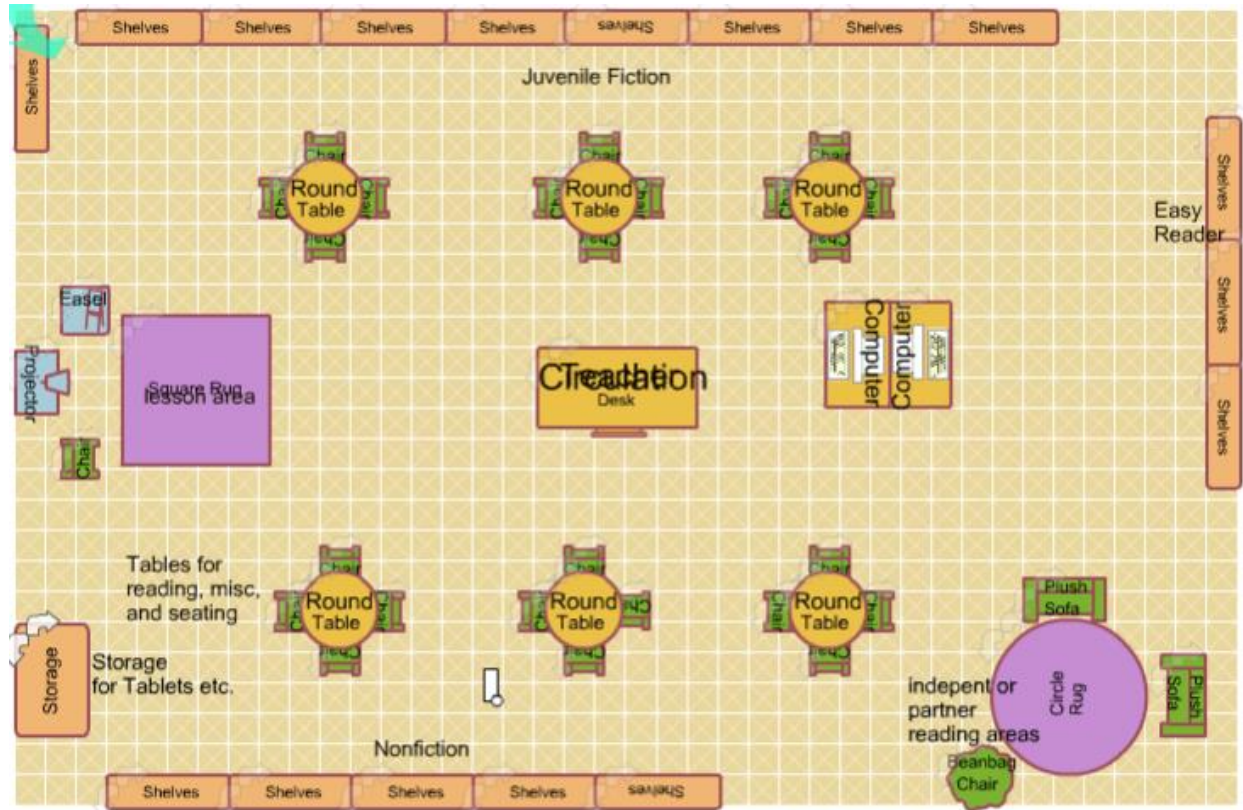


School Library Floor Plan



Modifications made on the CASE study school library floor plan is shown above.

The floor plan was designed for easy accessibility and openness. First thing first, by centralizing the circulation desk, it also opens more space for shelving on or near the walls. Students can quickly check out material and return to their seats at the new round table setting areas. The round tables are right for reading groups, and it also encourages imagination and creativity. Students may respectfully discuss with a peer the latest books or anything library near the round table. The round table seating also is great for maker spaces, since we are limited to space, the round table areas will be perfect to portable and instant makerspace crafts or activities. The Storage center that is near the tables will store all makerspace activities, tablets, and other tools students are free to use. Also for to encourage community and or independent partner reader, there is an area provided that is design for individual and partner reading or discussion. This area is different from the round table seating because it is design with more of a leisure feel. Students can read, study, or collect their thoughts in the space design with plush furnishing for comfortable lounging. Moving over towards the lesson area, there are not much changes the were made to the instruction space. The learning space has less traffic, which provides students with easy mobility to and from the area. It is also perfect for storytime with a preschooler and beyond. A chair and an easel is station there for the librarian use only.

The librarian has the option to present flannel stories and share readings in the lesson area. The computer station is centralized to the right of the circulation desk; this change was made because it allows students to easily collected prints from the circulation desk. Also, in the case of tech issues, the librarian is near, and it will allow for easy access and limit unnecessary traffic. Shelving is also another factor that plays a significant role. Booking shelving outlines the library, which will enable students easy access to books and materials. Due to the limit amount of nonfiction and easy readers, I was able to decrease the shelving units. This will then leave room for other stations shortly. This design allows for flexibility, accessibility, and openness.
